

## EGSS Anti-Austerity Survey and Motions

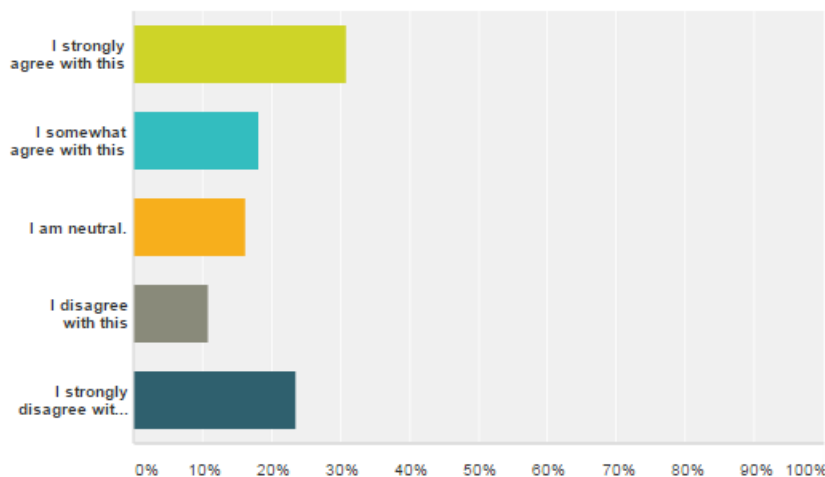
As a result of the findings from the survey and an EGSS council meeting, the following motions were put in place:

*Be it Resolved that, following the findings from a survey distributed to the EGSS membership, the EGSS and its constituents agree with the PGSS stance that affirms “complete and definitive opposition to the austerity measures in their actual form; commitment to support other Quebec student associations in their efforts against such measures”, and*

*Be it Resolved that, following the findings from a survey distributed to the EGSS membership and council discussion, the EGSS and its constituents will not be holding a general assembly to discuss student actions such as striking.*

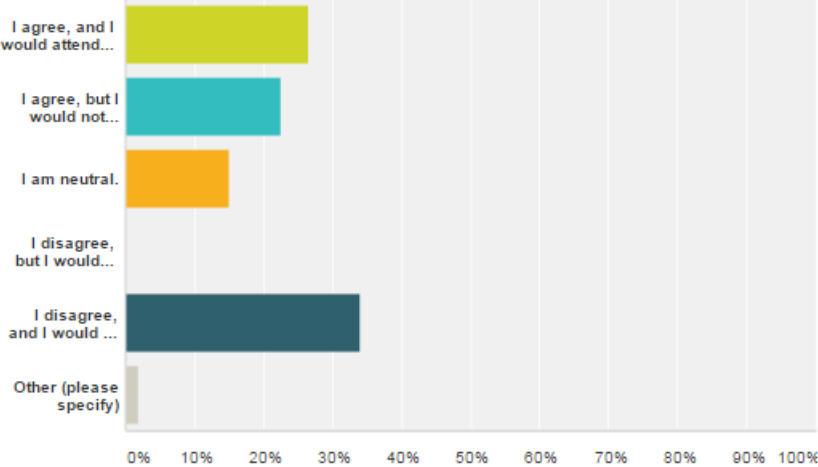
### Survey findings
